

INSTRUCTIONS FOR PREPARING YOUR PHOTO FOR HERON/OSPREY ROOM

STEP 1 – CROPPING YOUR PHOTO TO A 11 X 14 INCH ASPECT RATIO

Your photo will be sized to 11 X 14 inches for printing. It is important that you, as the photographer, crop the photo to an 11 X 14 aspect ratio and it will then be sized to 11 X 14 inches during export.

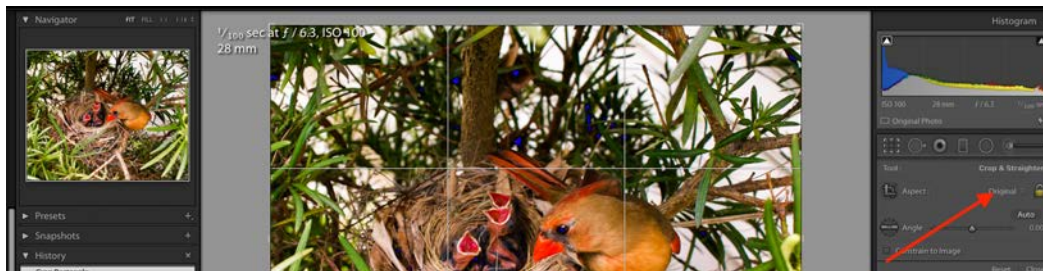
Open and select your photo in Lightroom Classic
Go to the “Develop” Module



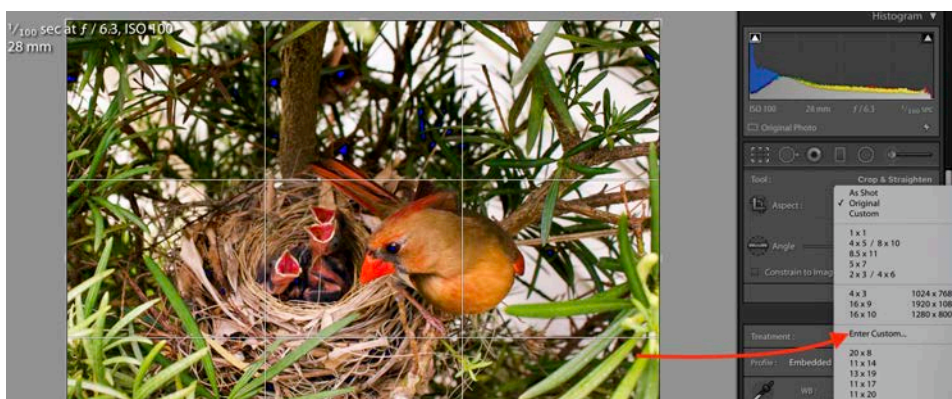
Select “Crop Overlay”



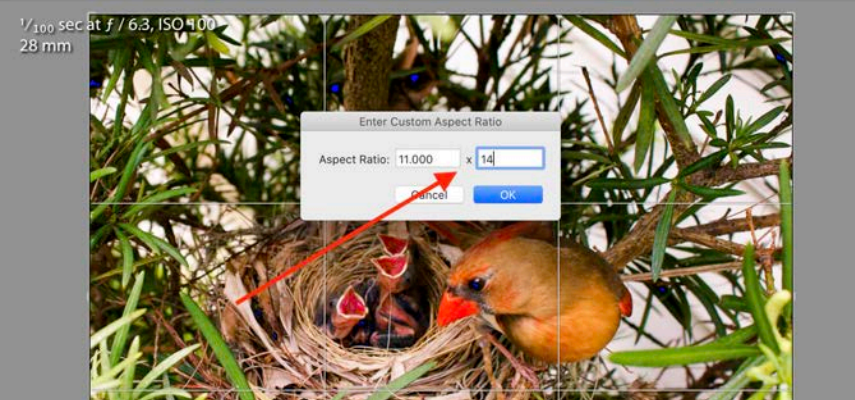
Select “Aspect”



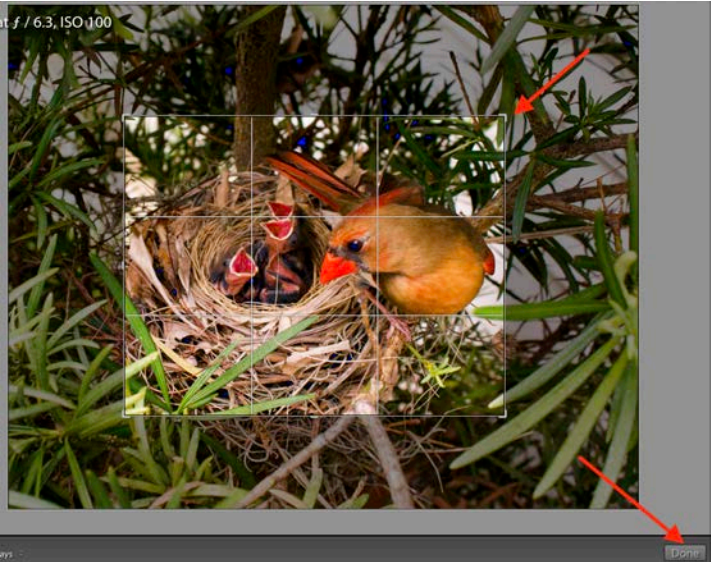
Select “Enter Custom” (to create an aspect ratio of 11 X 14 which is not a default)



Enter "11" x "14". This will create your aspect ratio.

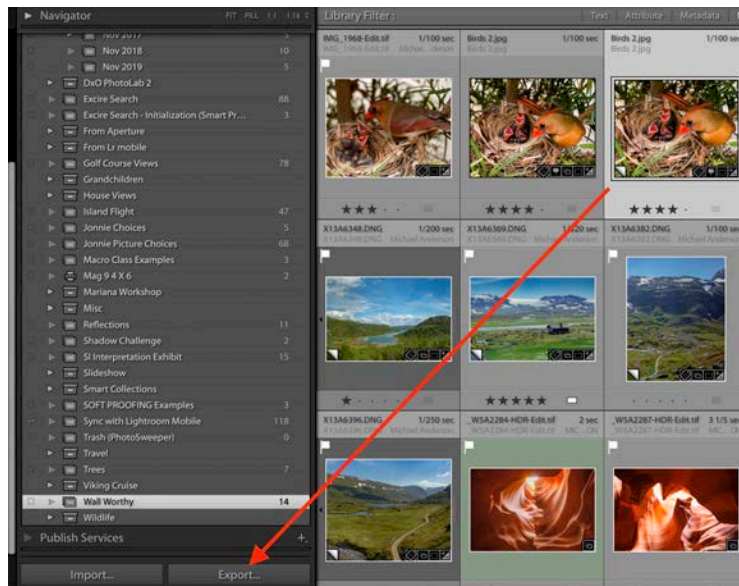


Adjust crop, making sure you don't cut off any parts of the subject. Consider composition. When done, select done.

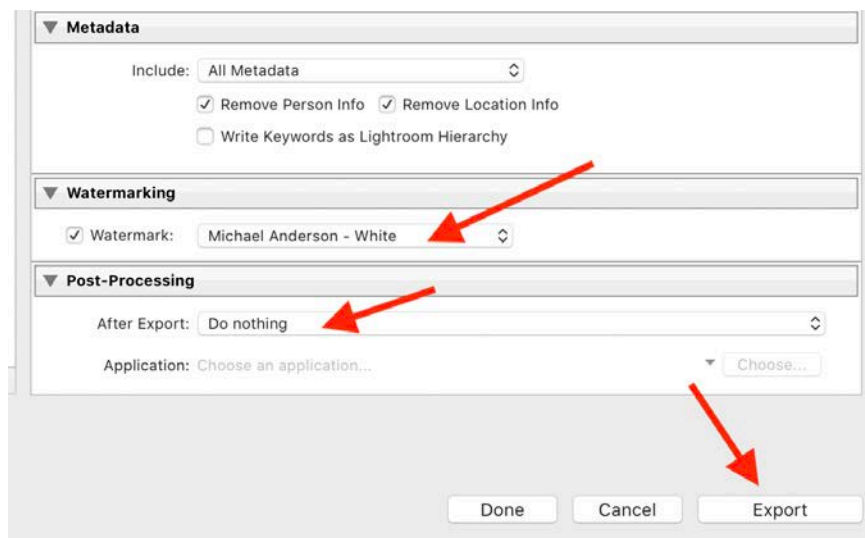
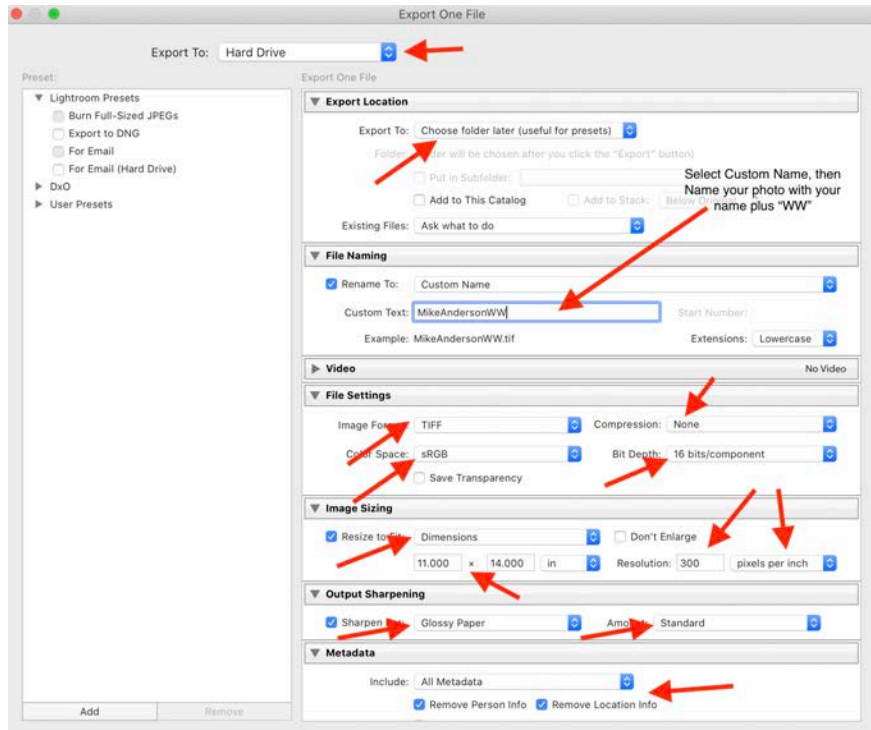


STEP 2 – EXPORTING YOUR PHOTO

Return to the “Library Module”, then Select “Export”



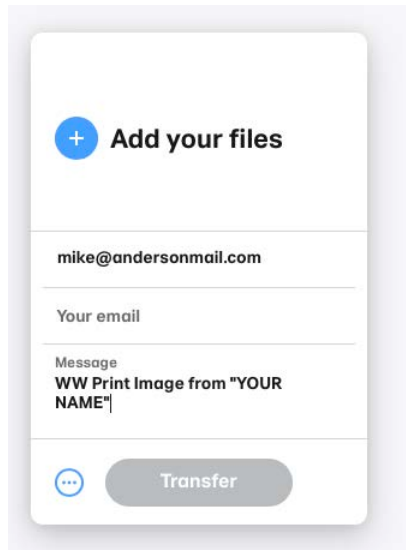
Set all the options in the “Export” dialog box as shown. Name your photo with your name plus “WW”. If you desire to use a WaterMark. Following the instructions on the CIPC web site for Watermark size and placement. Click on “Export” when done.



Navigate to a folder or location on your Hard Disk, Select Open and your file will be saved.

STEP 3 – SENDING YOUR PHOTO.

Your file size is going to be quite large and so the file cannot be sent via email. It is recommended you use “WeTransfer” which can be accessed at <https://wetransfer.com>. In the “wetransfer” dialog, send the transfer to mike@andersonmail.com in the message box add “WW Print Image from "YOUR NAME"”. This will assist me in determining files received.



You can also deliver the file to me using a “Thumb” drive.
